Camille and Mary Lerouge Memorial Award

- must be a French Immersion student
- show a keen commitment to community service

C. Neil Downey Award for Environmental Studies

- high achieving academic student
- registered for post-secondary studies in Environmental Sciences, Conservation, Environmental Engineering or Biological Sciences

Colleen Flett Memorial

- involvement as a school ambassador
- committed to school --> academics and attendance
- contribute to student welfare
- show consideration for others

Cornish Harder Niederle Award for Studies in Business and Accounting

- excelled in level 10, 20 or 30 financial management (attach transcript showing marks)
- plan to pursue a career in business or accounting

Fred Turnbull Scholarship for Achievement in English

- English 10/20/30 final marks are considered (attach transcript)
- demonstrate excellent written communication
- contribute to student welfare
- be involved in school activities
- personal qualities and attitude are considered

Harry Scissons Memorial Scholarship for the Arts

- enroll in a post-secondary Fine Arts program
- demonstrate positive attitude, commitment, resourcefulness and creativity

John Andrew Memorial Scholarship

- must be registered in an apprenticeship program
- completion of regular high school diploma requirements

LA Radio Group Scholarship

- presented to a student who is enrolled in a broadcasting, or radio and television production program

Louis Edward Hoffman Memorial Award

- enrolled in a post-secondary program

- 60 – 80 % average
- display good work ethic
- should not be receiving another award, except Rutherford

Maureen Barmby Scholarship

- recognizes hard working students who are committed to religious studies
- active in both school and parish communities
- pursuing post secondary education
- average in 30 level courses of 65% or better

Mike Podesta Memorial Award

- enroll in a Business related post-secondary program
- must have completed credits in either Information Processing or Financial Management classes (attach transcript)

Red Deer Fish and Game Association Scholarship

- awarded to a student pursuing studies in Fish / wildlife, forestry or environmental sciences
- preference may be given to a student who holds, or a family member who holds, a current membership with Red Deer Fish and Game Association

Robert Lee Hepworth Memorial Award

- enrolled in a Business related post-secondary program
- candidate will be chosen on the basis of grade 12 academic marks. Information Processing 30 and Financial Management 30 may be used to substitute for a core class

Rotary Club of Red Deer Sunrise Mel Stevenson Memorial Award

- presented to a student who excelled in art throughout high school

Student Council Award

- must have 70 % average or higher
- recognizes student who provided service to others in the school (eg. Tutoring, Leadership, Peer Career Coaching, Students for Justice, Student Council member, Yearbook, etc.)

- Students must be entering a Bachelor of Science program in a recognized Alberta post-secondary institution
- Applications will submit a short essay described on the application page
