Highlights

- We are exceptionally proud of our Quality of Education measure of 92.8%. Our staff continues to create the best educational experience for each student at École Secondaire Notre Dame High School.
- We continue to offer a great educational experience for our students and offer them many different courses, options and support to be successful. We saw growth in Education Quality, Welcoming and Caring Learning Environments, Access to Supports and Services and Parental Involvement.
- Our 3-year and 5-year High School Completion rates were both well above the provincial average. Our 3-year completion rate was 90.3% and 5-year completion rate was 92.7%.

Targeted Areas

This year, École Secondaire Notre Dame High School is focused on fostering an educational environment that engages all stakeholders in the growth and development of students through engagement and connection. - 96% Students, parents and staff believe that our school encourages the development of faith through various opportunities to encounter Christ and make meaningful connections to their faith.
- 92% Students recognize the opportunities they have to come together and pray as a community of believers.
- 92% Parents report seeing evidence that their child learns about the Catholic faith in our school.
- 100% Staff believe that we encourage students to understand the church's mission to help the community through a social justice commitment.

Future Priorities

- ✓ **Faith:** Our faith focus will consist of providing staff with opportunities to nurture their faith lives, with the goal that they will be able to openly share their faith authentically with students. This in turn will inspire student's own personal faith development.
- ✓ **Student Engagement:** This year our staff will focus on increasing student-to-content engagement through professional development and professional learning focused on high impact instructional strategies.
- ✓ **Teacher Mentorship:** The staff will be implementing a mentorship program and use professional development to support each other in improving their instructional teaching practices.
- ✓ **Trauma Informed:** As a school community, we are striving to increase staff-to-student connection and staff social/emotional efficacy in order to allow all students to experience success.
