Hello Graduation Class of 2025 students and families,

Graduation is getting close and as details are confirmed we want to make sure they are shared with you.

Graduation Caps and Gowns

- Will arrive in early June. Graduates will be able to pick up their gowns on Tuesday, **June 3 and Wednesday, June 4** in the Gathering Area. Graduates must pick up their own cap and gown and cannot pick up a gown for a friend.
- Students who are not on the current graduation list (not passing or completed all graduation requirements) will not be able to pick up their cap and gown on these days.
- Students will keep their caps and gowns until the conclusion of the morning Graduation Ceremony on **Friday, June 27**. Please be careful with your rental gowns, V-stols, caps and tassels. There are no extras and students will be charged for any missing gowns or V-stols. Students keep their cap and tassel.

Graduation Mass

- Graduation Mass will be held in the École Secondaire Notre Dame High School gymnasium on Friday, **June 6 at 11:00 a.m.**
- Students must wear their cap and gown for the Graduation Mass. Students who were not on the graduation list (not passing or completed all graduation requirements) on the June 3 and 4 pickup days will be provided their cap and gown just prior to Graduation Mass but will be required to return them at the conclusion of Mass.

Graduation Rehearsal

- Graduation rehearsal will take place on **Thursday, June 26 at 5pm** at the Peavey Mart Centrium at Westerner Park. All graduates must attend. This rehearsal will take approximately 90 minutes. Please arrive on time.

Graduation Ceremony (Morning Event)

- The morning Graduation Ceremony (diploma presentations) will be on **Friday, June 27** at the Peavey Mart Centrium at Westerner Park starting at 9:00 a.m.
- Graduates must arrive in cap and gown by 8:30 a.m. Graduates enter and line up alphabetically as was done in the rehearsal. Centrium doors will open to the public at 8:30 a.m.
- The morning ceremony includes Prayer, Valedictorian Address, presentation of Diplomas and address from our Grade 12 Administration team. The morning ceremony will conclude by 11:30 a.m. Gowns and V-stols will be collected from grads as they exit the ceremony.
- Tickets are not needed for the morning event.

Graduation Celebration (Evening Event)

- Tickets are required to attend the Graduation Celebration (Evening Event).
- Tickets will go on sale on **Tuesday, June 3 at noon**. Tickets are \$21 each. Graduates do not need to purchase a ticket but all guests must have a ticket to attend the evening celebration. Tickets can only

be purchased through Rycor on the parent powerschool account and are not available at the school. There is no limit on the number of tickets graduates can purchase. Tickets will be available for purchase until **Friday, June 20.**

- If the \$45 graduation fundraising fee has not been paid or flowers were not sold, the fundraising fee will be added to the cost of your first ticket. Outstanding school fees and library fines will be added to your ticket purchase as well.
- Our evening celebration begins at 7:00 p.m. in the Peavey Mart Centrum at Westerner Park. We begin with a Grand March of all of our grads across the stage. We encourage graduates to walk across the stage with their friends. Students will deliver a tribute to parents and staff. Once the tributes are complete, our DJ will get the celebration started! The dance will continue until 10:30 p.m. on ice level. Clusters of tables will be set up around the Concourse level with sweets and treats and refreshments. We encourage families to stay and celebrate.
